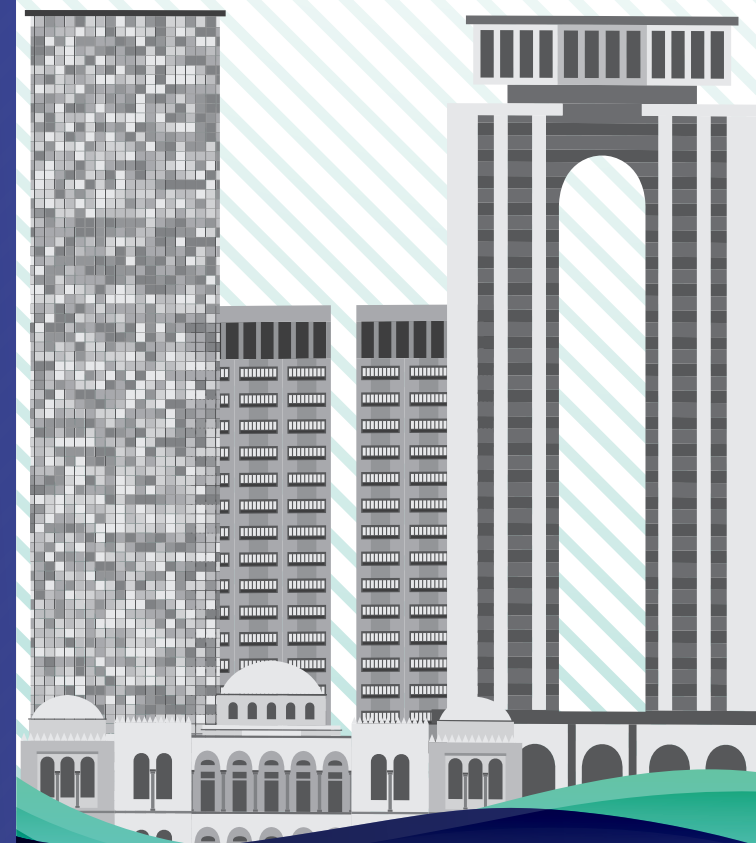

Objectives

E-NABLE has **three main objectives**:

01 | **Strengthening the capacities of the Ministry of Economy and Trade and related stakeholders in designing public policies for economic diversification.**

- Improving evidence-based decision-making by **providing and analyzing data**.
- Supporting reforms, facilitating **business creation, and promoting** domestic and foreign investment.
- Creating a common and concerted vision on issues of sustainable **economic development**.

02 | **Leveraging digital innovations for inclusive and sustainable development in Libya.**

- Strengthening the capacities of the **Ministry of Economy and Trade** the General Information Authority, Tax Department, the Ministry of Finance and the Chambers of Commerce to adopt the digital strategy and use digital tools.
- Increasing the use of digital technologies in **Libyan economic institutions**.

03 | **Encouraging financial institutions to extend credit to the private sector and provide financial tools and solutions to SMEs.**

- Developing an organizational framework for **establishing a leasing company** for accessing credit.
- Restructuring the **Libyan Credit Bureau**.
- Creating an **enabling environment** for microfinance and Fintech.
